


Fig. 6.1 – Sources of data can be both numerous and varied.

GIS Data Costs




Fig. 6.2 – Data collection costs vs. implementation time in years. The above figure shows a typical cost curve resulting from the introduction of GIS into a larger organisation.

How do GIS Attributes Function?




Fig. 6.12 – The integration of document and scanned images within GIS. For example, it is possible to point at a building and bring up an image of the corresponding deed.
